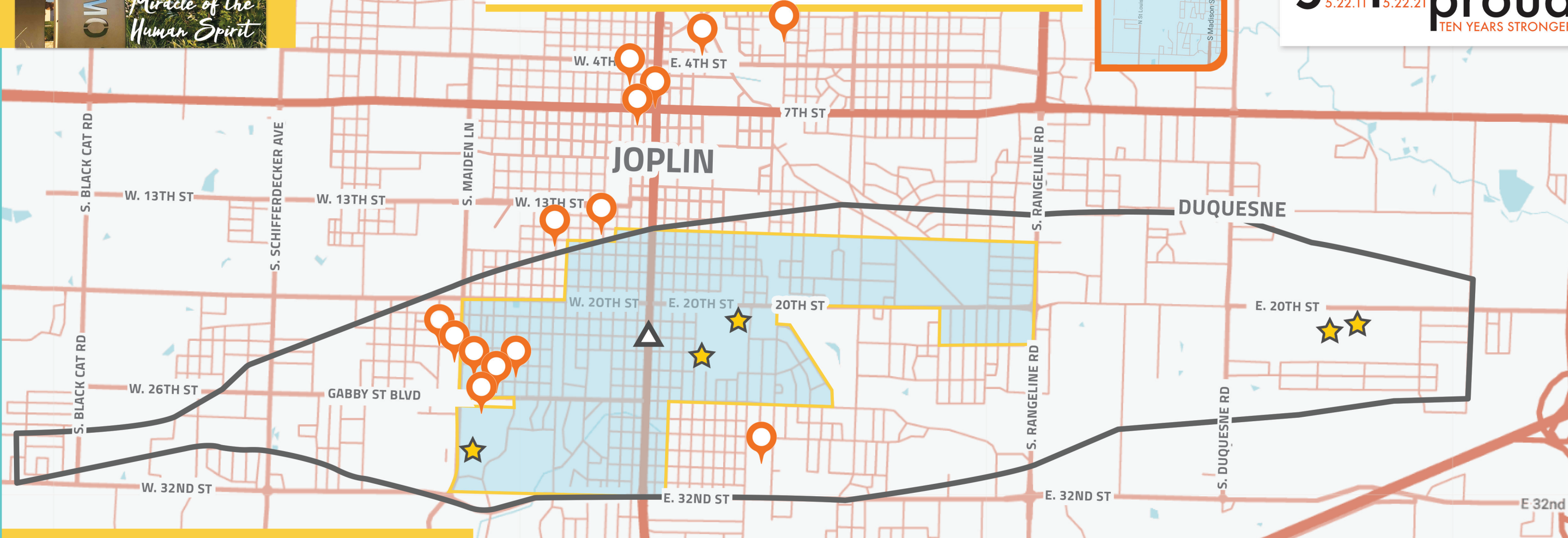
Joplin Moves Forward
